

# FRONT RUNNERS



Two 54-hour-old zebrafish embryos that were injected with 3000 dsRed-expressing *E. coli* at the age of 30 hours. The bacteria have spread throughout the body, but healthy fish will eventually eliminate them through innate immune mechanisms.
