

**Movie 1.** Peahens shift their gaze while freely moving in their environment. The first clip shows a peahen making a small gaze shift. The total gaze shift is  $20^{\circ}$ , with the head movement contributing  $18^{\circ}$  and the eye movement contributing only  $2^{\circ}$ . The second clip shows a peahen making a large gaze shift. The total gaze shift is  $60^{\circ}$ , with the head movement contributing  $33^{\circ}$  and the eye movement contributing  $27^{\circ}$ . The yellow dot indicates where the bird is looking within the environment and the eye movement is displayed in the upper right corner.
