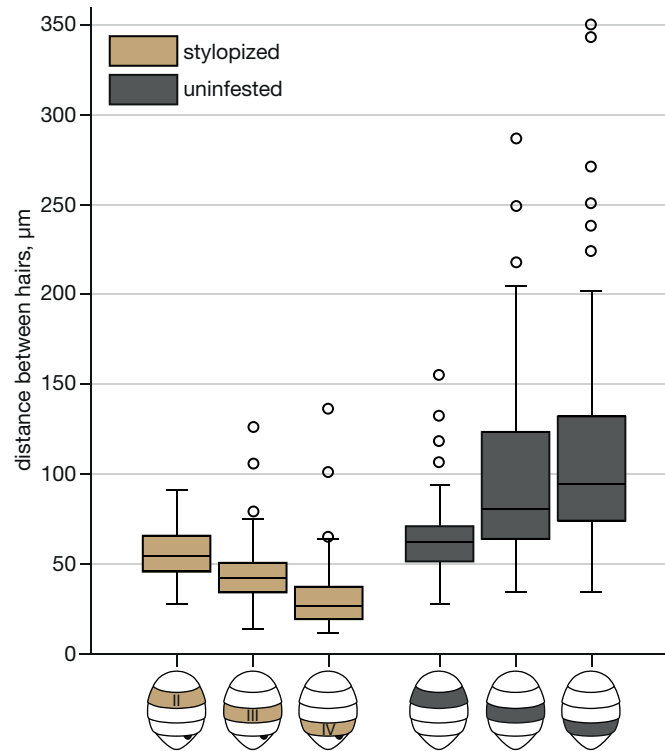


Figure S2. Distance between hairs of the abdominal tergites II-IV of the abdomen of stylized and uninfested females of *Andrena vaga*.

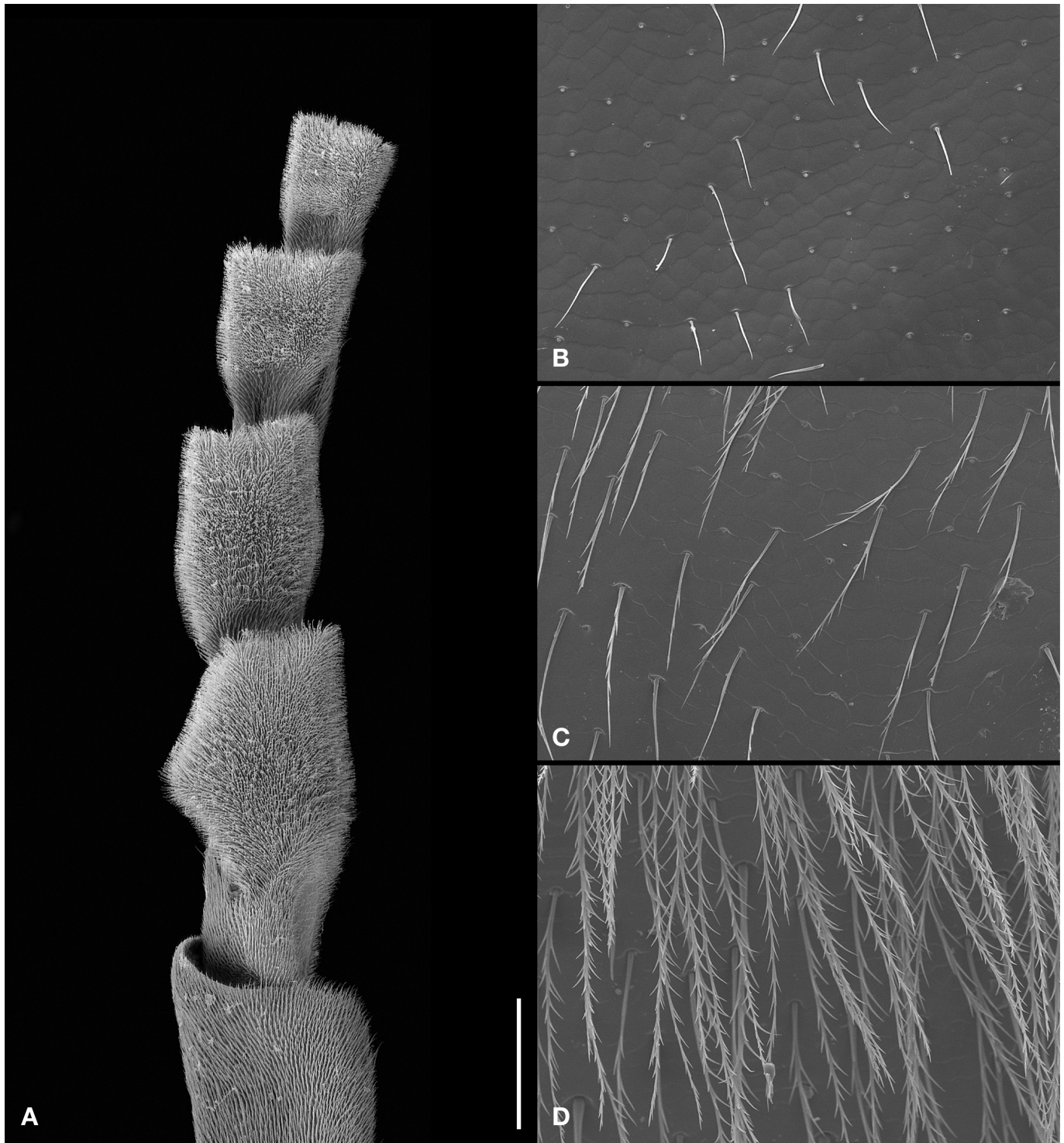

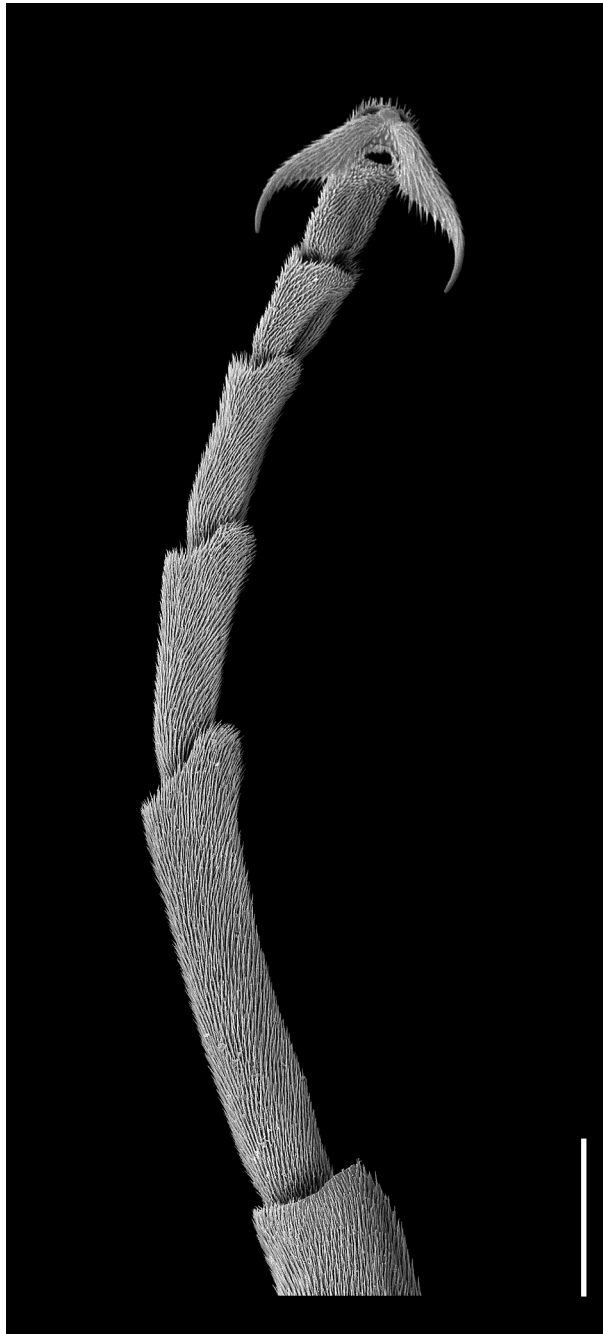
